Antique Car Show: From 9 a.m.- 3 p.m. on Saturday, check out the top coats and under the hoods of vintage vehicles from all over. This free admission event will be in the BancorpSouth parking lot at 300 N. Trenton St. in downtown Ruston.

Peach Parade: The "Peachy Paradise" parade will be on Saturday, June 23 at 9 am! The parade route begins at the LA Tech Thomas Assembly Center, continues east on Alabama Ave., south on Trenton St., west on Dan Reneau Dr., then returns to the Thomas Assembly Center.
